Since then, Republicans have repealed the DACA order, begun a new health care debate, and opened up a debate over whether to keep funding the government. This editorial is being published again. The shutdown and subsequent impasse in Washington are taking an enormous toll on the federal workers and contractors whose lives and livelihoods are suspended in time. Despite the furious threats from President Trump to "close down the country," the federal government can close only key operations. The federal workers employed by the executive branch have been kept on the job — but not paid. The same is true of contractors. A huge number of federal workers are now relying on their private sector employers for health care and life insurance. This is because the large number of these workers who are furloughed or working without pay live paycheck-to-paycheck, and cannot afford to sign up for benefits. The result is that the shutdown is hitting these workers even harder than the ordinary furloughed employee who can fall back on the insurance they had before. And the number of workers and contractors affected is likely to grow. In the private sector, the cost of providing that insurance is borne by workers and employers alike. In the federal government, the
